Dear Law School Representative,

We at **Arizona State University** are looking forward to seeing you at our annual Law School Fair on Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2009! Thanks to your participation, the Law School Fair is always very popular with the ASU community, and we welcome you to the Valley of the Sun. Last year's event was a great success, with over 100 law schools and over 450 students and alumni in attendance.

Here are some brief reminders about the event:

**Event:**           **Law School Fair**

**Time:**           **10 a.m.-2 p.m.**

**Date:**           **Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2009**

**Location:**   **Arizona & Ventana Rooms of the Memorial Union, Arizona State University,  
Tempe campus**

**Parking:** Parking is reserved for the ASU Law School Fair and will be in the Apache Boulevard Structure, formerly named Parking Structure #1 (please see attached map). The structure entrance is located just north of the Normal Avenue and Apache Boulevard intersection. Our pre-law student organization volunteers will assist you if you need to park at our back-up lot, Rural Road Parking Structure. After lunch, you will receive a validation sticker to be placed on your parking ticket; please bring your parking ticket with you to the Fair. We also recommend that you arrive early to avoid traffic entering the structure.

There is also a light rail stop located within walking distance of the Memorial Union. Please visit [http://www.valleymetro.org/metro\\_light\\_rail/](http://www.valleymetro.org/metro_light_rail/) for more information regarding the light rail system.

**Directions:** I have included directions to ASU from Sky Harbor Airport and from Tucson, as I know many of you will be coming up from the University of Arizona's Law Fair, held the day before ours. Additional driving directions may be found at <http://www.asu.edu/map/directions.html>.

- From Sky Harbor Airport:
  - Take Loop 202 East to Scottsdale/Rural Rd. (Exit 7).
  - Turn right (south) onto Rural Road and proceed to Apache Boulevard.
  - Turn right (west) onto Apache.
  - Turn right (north) onto Normal Avenue.
  - Turn left (west) onto Lemon Street, and the entrance to the Parking Structure will be on your left.
  
- From Tucson / Southern Arizona:
  - Take Interstate Highway I-10 west to US Highway 60 east.
  - Take US Highway 60 east to the Rural Road exit.
  - Turn left (north) onto Rural Road and proceed to Apache Boulevard.
  - Turn left (west) onto Apache.
  - Turn right (north) onto Normal Avenue.
  - Turn left (west) onto Lemon Street, and the entrance to the Parking Structure will be on your left.

**Accommodations:** If you are unfamiliar with the Tempe/Phoenix area, included below is a short list of hotels that are located near ASU's Tempe Campus. (These hotels may also provide shuttle service to and from ASU).
